

Global stocks edged lower on Wednesday.

- Fed meeting minutes reiterated Fed's cautious approach
- The USD index gained while USTs bonds fell
- Oil prices gained on OPEC+ status quo



Macroeconomic news

- The minutes from the US Federal Reserve's May 6-7 meeting revealed that officials are grappling with rising inflation and unemployment, alongside concerns about financial market volatility and recession risks. Policymakers acknowledged that bond market fluctuations warranted close monitoring, as they could pose risks to financial stability.
- Germany unemployment rate rose sharply in May, the number of unemployed increased by 34K in seasonally adjusted terms to 2.96mn, more than analysts' forecasts of an increase of 10K. The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained at 6.3%.
- France's GDP grew 0.1% QoQ in Q1'25, matching the preliminary estimates while expanded 0.6% YoY, lower than previous estimates.

Rates and Fixed Income

- 10Y UST yields ended higher despite healthy foreign demand on 5Y USTs auction. JGB bond yields rose after 40Y debt auction received weak demand.
- Fixed income indices declined, led by Global Treasuries.

Currencies

- The broader USD index edged higher on Wednesday.
- ▶ The EUR, GBP and JPY weakened against the USD.

Equities

- Global stock markets experienced declines, with major indices in the US, Europe, and Asia closing lower. The DJIA fell 0.58%, the S&P 500 fell 0.56% and the Nasdaq Composite fell 0.51%. Europe's STOXX 600 finished 0.61% lower. UK's FTSE fell 0.59%.
- GCC markets ended mixed. Saudi Arabia outperformed while Qatar underperformed the most.

Commodities

- Oil prices gained as OPEC+ did not change its output policy.
- Gold prices ended lower on strong USD.
